Answer one of the two assignments:

EITHER

Analyse how mise-en-scène in season 1, episode 4 of Game of Thrones serves narrative purposes, using concepts from your assigned readings. The episode is available from computers in Norway at <<http://tv.nrk.no/serie/game-of-thrones/KOIF95008410/sesong-1/episode-4>>

OR

Choose an adventure game, and analyse how the game-world contributes to gameplay on one hand and atmosphere and immersion on the other. Discuss how the gaming experience is shaped by the game-world, using concepts from your assigned readings.

The exam is to be written in English.

The submitted paper may be up to 10 pages (one page is calculated to 2300 characters without spaces), excluding front page and references.
