

INFORMATION ABOUT CASE MEETING:

- The case meeting date can be found in your schedule in Mine Studier
- The case meeting is a part of the 5 mandatory courses in pediatrics. In total you can be absent from 2 of these. Thus, you can be absent from the case meeting if you attend at least 3 other courses.
- In the case meeting, students will, in pairs or alone if they wish, present a patient case from one of the patient records they have taken. Hence, one patient record must be done before the case meeting so you have something to present on.
- The record may be taken at the acute ward (ideally) or you can go to any of the other pediatric in-patient wards (I would suggest contacting the doctor on call if you plan to do this, I have not organized a sign up.) -Obviously, you may only go to the acute ward to take a patient record at your allotted time slot.
- At the case meeting, everybody should be prepared to make a presentation.
- The presentation will be 5-7 minutes going over the patient history, findings in the clinical examination etc, 5-7 minutes general background and information about the disease of the patient and finally 5 minutes for questions/discussion. Total 15 minutes.
- You can use powerpoint if you want to, but make sure to email it to yourself so you can pull it up on a hospital computer.
- The patient record you present at the case meeting will count for one of the four mandatory records, so you will only need 3 additional records from the acute ward.
- It is ok that two people hand in a patient record on the same patient, just write the record in your own words so that they are not 100 % similar. And mark the record with your case meeting date and the name of the partnering student as well.
