Discuss **one** of the following topics:

EITHER:

2A. Outline the major features of the Norwegian system of labour relations. Discuss the importance of direct relations between the social partners (unions and employers associations) as compared to the role of tripartite relations (social partners and the state).

OR:

2B. Do you consider "the Nordic Model" a useful concept? Discuss at least two ways of understanding such a model.

OR:

2C. Define the concept of citizenship. Analyse *one* out of these three areas with reference to citizenship: the welfare state, immigration, gender relations.
