5.1. Arriving in Australia

Students MUST arrive in Australia in the week of 26th December.

Why?

As part of NSW Health Compliance, COVID vaccinations must be recorded on the [Australian Immunisation Register \(AIR\)](#) by a doctor practicing in Australia. Before this, you need to apply for an IHI number which can only be applied for when you arrive in Australia. All of this can take up to 2 weeks during the Christmas and New Year break.

5.2. NSW Health Compliance

After you are accepted and to satisfy the requirements for the New South Wales (NSW) Department of Health, you must provide the documentation by September.

UNSW is bound by NSW Health rules, and if you are not Compliant, you cannot commence your placement.

5.3. Complete HETI e-learning Modules

All students who go on placement in a NSW Health Facility are required to complete the **mandatory** training and e-learning from the Department of Health, Education and Training (HETI).

Students are required to complete approximately 10 modules which take approximately 10 minutes each.
