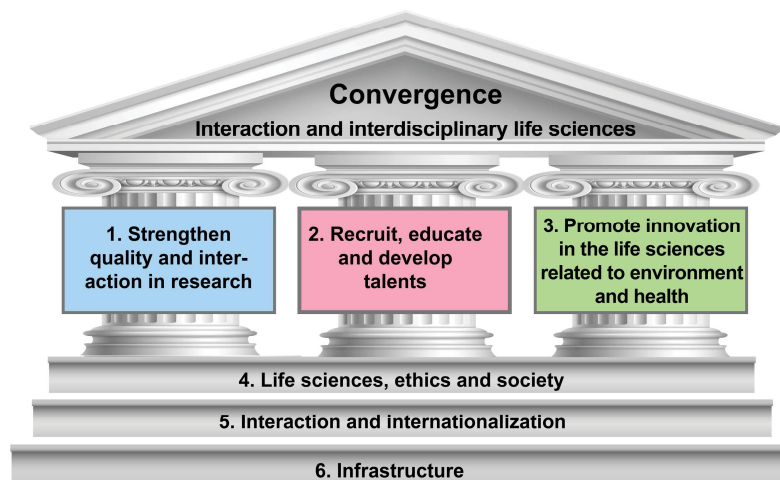
- 8 Faculties and 2 university museums

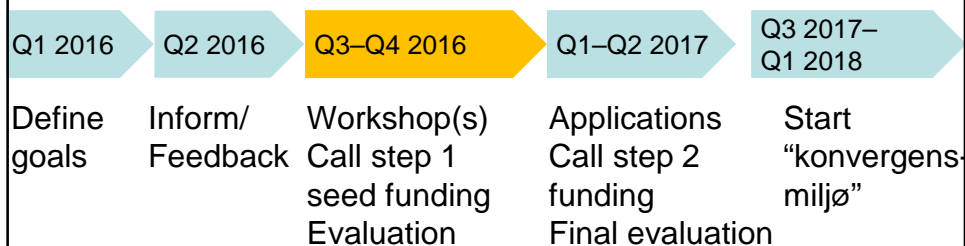


Convergence environments

- Cluster funding
 - 3–4 positions
 - Expenditures (max 250 KNOK/year/experimental position)
 - Own funding
- Total number
 - About 6–9



Process for selection – timeline





Step 1: Sketch

- Mandatory for full application
 - All sketches eligible for step 2
- Deadline October 28th
- Webform (Nettskjema)
- 2 attachments to upload
 - 1 project description (max 4 pages including figures and references, single pdf file)
 - CVs (max 5 persons, max 10 pages, single pdf file)
- Responsible UiO unit (e.g. department) required for full application, but not for sketch.
 - Letter from dep. head or similar describing strategic significance and own contribution

Speed dating logistics

- Groups of 2-4 persons
- One moderator per topic
- Matrix set up to ensure a maximum number of dates
- 10 rounds
- 4 – 8 tables (depending on no. of participants in topic)
- 8 min per round
 - Each participant should not spend more that 1 min to present their project
 - 4 minutes for general discussion
- 2 min to change table
- Signal after 7 min and after 8 min
- Moderator will inform when 4 min is passed
- You have a “scorecard” to make notes
