Obligatory attendance

- ▶ All courses at ILOS will have a minimum requirement of 60% attendance starting this semester
- ▶ The 40% allowed absence is meant to cover illness, travel, work and other reasons, and you will not get a valid absence based on documentation
- ▶ What the requirement means specifically in each course is listed under «Teaching» on the individual course pages

Part-time, leave of absence and delay during your graduate studies.

- ▶ You can apply for part-time studies and leave of absence.
- ▶ Deadlines for applications: September 1st and February 1st.

- ▶ Absences or delays that are not pre-approved could in some cases lead to you losing your spot in the program.
- ▶ If you get delayed with your thesis in your fourth (last) semester, you can apply for a 5th semester.
