- 1. Give a brief outline of the history of abstract painting in Norway.
- 2. Describe the project of *The Frieze of Life* by Edvard Munch.
- 3. Describe a stave church portal and mention some theories about the function and meaning of the pictorial programme.
- 4. Describe a Norwegian classicist building.
