Give examples, with formal description and an analysis, of some of the most central works of art in these two artistic projects. Please include a short comparison with similarities and differences of the two projects.

Part II: Knowledge questions (approximately one hour):

Please answer **two** of the four following questions:



1. Describe and analyze a painting by Johan Christian Dahl.
2. Edvard Munch's graphic art: techniques and motifs.
3. Compare a painting by Adolph Tidemand with one by Christian Krohg. Discuss form and content, contrasts and similarities.
4. Building identification: which building is this and to which period does it belong? Please include a formal description.
