Pick one of the two following exam questions:

EITHER

Question 1

Discuss Roy Andersson's "complex image". Formulate your own research question. Use texts from the curriculum.

OR

Question 2

Conduct a comparative close reading of “SKAM” and “Heimebane”.
Formulate your own research question. Use texts from the curriculum.

You may submit your exam in Norwegian, Swedish, Danish or English.

The submitted paper should be approximately 10 pages (one page is calculated to 2300 characters without spaces) excluding front page and references. The exam must be submitted as a PDF file. Your front page must include your candidate number, and the name of the file you upload should be your candidate number (for instance 1234.pdf).
