

## Telders Moot Court Competition 2015

The [Telders International Law Moot Court Competition](#) (Telders Competition or Competition) has become one of the most prestigious and important moot court competitions in Europe. Annually, teams from over 40 universities compete in the national rounds, with the winning teams going on to represent their countries in the international rounds held at the Peace Palace in The Hague, the Netherlands. Through the Competition students are educated in legal practice and such principles as the rule of law, civil society and fair play. The Competition also stimulates team-work and European integration. Students and academics consider participation important, a great honour and a wonderful experience of a friendly and international competition never to be forgotten.

The selection of the UiO Telders team will be done on the basis of **three criteria**:

- (1) **prior knowledge of public international law (PIL)** and other fields of IL (participants must have taken at least a course on PIL or be currently enrolled in the JUS5540 Public International Law course);
- (2) **your CV and a short essay of no more than 700 words (footnotes included)** on the principle of exhaustion of domestic remedies, its rationale and place in international law; and
- (3) **an interview** with the selected candidates.
