

Consequences of Cheating

In the event of cheating or attempted cheating, the consequences can be annulment of exams and exclusion for up to one year from UiO and all other universities and university colleges in Norway.

Cheating is a violation of academic integrity. Academic integrity means being honest in respect of thoughts and reflections that are one's own and those borrowed from the work of others.

You may be suspected of cheating or attempted cheating if you:

- fail to provide information about sources (home examination)
- give the impression that a paper is more independent than it actually is (home examination)
- use support materials or assistants that are not allowed (written school examinations)
