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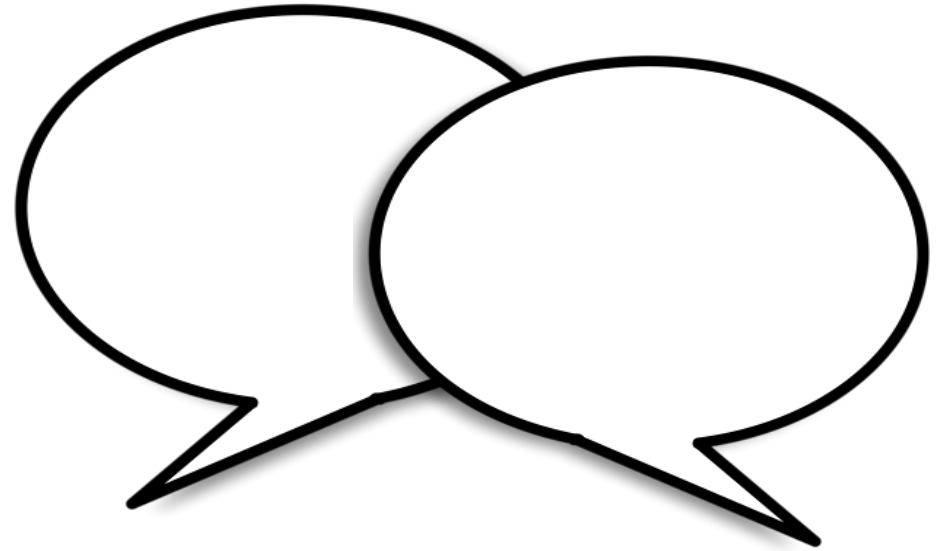
Design the *ideal* wallet for your fellow student

Structure
