About the exam in INF-GEO4310 2011

There will be a four hour written exam on December 16, 14:30 - 18:30.

The exam will consist of two different types of questions:

- 1. Multiple-choice questions where five alternatives are given and only one alternative is the correct one. Here you will get 4 points for a correct answer, -1 for an incorrect answer, and 0 if you do not answer. Choosing an alternative at random will on the average give you 0 points here! If you mark the right answer, and guard with some extra crosses, you will loose 1 point for each incorrect cross.
- 2. Questions where you will have to find the answer yourself. It is important that you give brief and "to-the-point" answers, but indicate how you are thinking, and give reasons for your answer.

You will NOT be allowed to bring your lecture notes or the texts handed out during the course, or any other written or printed material, with ONE important exception:

You will ONLY be allowed to bring one sheet of standard A4 paper, together with your personal pocket calculator.

On this sheet of A4 paper you may write, print or draw whatever you like, on both sides, in the font, style, size and colors you like.

We would suggest that you spend some time and effort preparing this sheet!

And we suggest that you start now!

It may be a good idea to go through the papers, lecture notes and your personal notes from the course, and try to condense the essentials onto a few pages.

Then iteratively condense this further down to what fits onto the two pages of an A4 sheet. We are confident that this will be a valuable learning process, and that it will prepare you well for the exam. In the end, you might not need the text you have prepared!
