 - Recoding objects and social structures


Fairphone

Points of thought

- Disposal, salvage, recycle, remanufacturing for reuse, reuse as-is, achieving longevity of use, sharing for maximum use, achieve heirloom status, finding wholesome alternatives to use, active repair of misuse
