# What is recoding?

---

- Mostly used for programming code
    - put (something, especially a computer program) into a different code
  - Can be used in a wider context
    - Recoding objects and social structures

# Points of thought

---

- Consider environmental impact (Blevis, 2007)
    - Disposal, salvage, recycle, remanufacturing for reuse, reuse as-is, achieving longevity of use, sharing for maximum use, achieve heirloom status, finding wholesome alternatives to use, active repair of misuse
  - Six strategies for elimination design (Fry, 2009)
  - All recoding projects are different!
