

Emergency ward duty and pediatric records

- All students must complete and hand in 4 patient records, written in Norwegian or English
 - We will give You correction and feedback
- One of these is to be presented and handed in at a case meeting together with another student and can be done about a patient admitted to the pediatric ward or a new patient at the acute ward
- The other three records must be done at the acute ward and only one student per patient
- Only one student per patient
- The records should be completed at the hospital, then printed out and handed in to us
- If you have to go home before you know your patients results and diagnosis, you must check this the next day and fill in your record before handing it in
- You need to delivered the file within 2 weeks

- Hand in records in “INBOX” in the basement (**University section**) at the Childrens Center (Barnesenteret) at Ullevål or in our mailboxes in front of the Outpatient Clinic (Poliklinikk)

Patient records from Ahus
