## Exam questions SGO2200

The students are to answer **three** out of four questions.

1. Economic globalization has one empirical meaning (actually existing economic globalization) and one ideological/political meaning. Present the two meanings. Why is it problematic that the two meanings sometimes are confused?
2. The rise of China is arguably the most important development in the global economy since the 1990s. In what ways have the rise of China been especially significant to the global economy?
3. Present and discuss how states regulate their economies to control what happens within and across their borders. Use examples.
4. What patterns of income inequality have been established since the 1980s? How can rising income inequality be related to economic globalization?
