- 2) In a discrete-time hazard model for mortality from cardiovascular diseases in Norway in 1980-2014, the following estimates (odds ratios) were obtained for men of age 60-79 years:

- a) Do these estimates seem plausible compared to other such effects you have read about in the course? Only a brief answer is expected.
- b) What do you think are the reasons for the effect of education that you see in the table? Explain thoroughly.
- c) Assume that you are interesting in learning about the long-term health effect of helping more young adults to complete secondary school (i.e. reduce the drop-out rate). Would these estimates tell you anything of importance about the size of this effect? Do you think there might be health effects on other individuals than those encouraged through such a program to take a few more years of secondary education?
- 3) Life expectancy at birth is currently more than one year shorter in Denmark than in Norway, as an average across the sexes. What kind of factors do you think are most likely to have

caused this difference? Feel free to speculate. You are not expected to search for statistical evidence in support of your hypotheses.

4) A journalist calls you because she has seen that the difference in the life expectancy between women and men in Russia is 11 years. She says "I don't know much about this subject, but the difference seems to be very large. Can you give me a brief comment?"
