

The essay is judged according to the following criteria:

Is the social problem well described? Is it clear who the actors are, what their perspective on the social situation is, whether there is a divergence of perspectives? Is it clear what resources are at stake?

Is there a theoretical background introduced that explains judgments, feelings and behaviour? As examples, this can be RMT, but also other notions of distributive or procedural justice, etc.

Is the theoretical background appropriately used to explain the problem? Logical soundness of arguments is the main focus here.

Formal aspects considered:

- Proper use of APA style
- Proper structuring of the text, identifiable structuring in introduction, main part and analysis, and summary
- Proper referencing

Quality of English is not considered for the grade.
