

## Sensor Guide Exam PSYC2210 - Autumn 2019

The syllabus that is used for students to write their Exam for this course includes lecture material from five lectures. Students are to draw on any of the material from the lectures and the readings to answer the exam question. Students have two days to write their exam and can use any resources they wish in this because it is a take home open-book exam.

It is important to note that the exam questions can be answered in different ways. Students have been given a small amount of information in a hypothetical case. There are two parts to the question. The first asks students to consider the problem from a developmental and clinical perspective by considering possible causes of the problem. The second part of the question asks students to consider the case from either a prevention perspective or from an intervention perspective. Materials can be drawn from any of the lectures to answer the exam. The aim of this exam is to help the students apply their theoretical and clinical knowledge to a practical case and work out how to intervene.

The exam answer should be between 2-4000 words. APA referencing should be used throughout.
