The essay shall use the framework of Historical and Sociocultural Perspectives on Learning and Development to critically discuss the topic of choice. The candidate can refer to the SNE4130 and SNE3130 syllabus yet provide any external reference that is deemed relevant. The main focus of the essay may be either theoretical, epistemological, methodological or empirical. There is no criteria for the choice of the topic other than the relevance and the quality of the discussion.

The criteria of assessment are:

- Clarity and transparency of the paper
- Significance of the problem for theory, policy and/or practice
- · Clearly adopting a CHAT perspective to discuss the topic
- Connection with the SNE topics
- · Overall quality and scientific originality


Formal requirements
