- Select one of the above disabilities and give a description of the chosen disability (i.e., definition and characteristics)
- Describe some approaches for the assessment
- Discuss the strength and weakness of the approaches for the assessment
- Compare each approach for the assessment

Q 3: Write a literature review of relevant studies of psychosocial conditions and behavioral problems in the classroom with focus on the *teaching strategies* for inclusive (or individualized) education of students with psychosocial disability:

- a. Select one of the above disabilities and give a description of the chosen disability (i.e., definition and characteristics)
- b. Describe some teaching strategies
- c. Discuss the strength and weakness of the teaching strategies
- d. Compare each teaching strategy
