See power point for summary of Torgeir's talk. Also Tor Endestad made a short presentation of PSI's work with dicom images and the new IBM spectrum discovery tool incorporating the Brain Imaging Data Structure application and workflow.



### Project Gaia (Jonas Ulleland)

Project Gaia address the need for communication infrastructure facilitating horizontal communication at UIO. Horizontal communication is communication that based on needs and not contingent on the vertical organizational structure. The initial suggestion was to create one sharepointsite per hub which sources yammer feeds. Yammer is Microsoft office 365 social media platform for businesses and sharepoint is Microsoft office 365 application for creating intranets.

All commentators agreed that there is a need for more horizontal communication at UIO however the solution with Microsoft platform is not agreed upon. There was a suggestion to use Canvas as employees at UIO are already using canvas, but a counterargument was that canvas does not allow export of data. Another suggestion was to use Vortex with its blog function. Another issue was raised asking who will have access to the platform, that is user/access control. There was also some questions raised about funding and workforce to complete the solution.

Jonas argued that we already have license for Microsoft and a grassroot workforce can build the application and apply for funding to create a position which can maintain the solution. Jonas will continue this work through December and January and inform the network of the work mid-January.
